The Universities and Councils Network on Innovation for Inclusive Development in Southeast Asia (UNIID-SEA) and the ASEAN University Network (AUN) are launching a new grants program called the "**IID Fellows Program: Development of Teaching and Learning Packages on Innovation for Inclusive Development in Southeast Asia**." The program will award small grants to individuals for the development of their existing modules and courses that would help others to build the necessary knowledge and skills for *innovation for inclusive development* or IID.

IID is broadly defined as *"innovation that aims to reduce poverty and enables as many groups of people, especially the poor and marginalized, to participate in decision-making, create and actualize opportunities, and share the benefits of development"* (IID Program Prospectus, IDRC, 2011).

The program is open to interested applicants from the ten (10) ASEAN countries: Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam. USD 1,500 to USD 2,500 will be made available to each Fellow that will be chosen. Up to twenty (20) Fellows will be named by June 2014.

The deadline for submission of applications is on **MAY 31, 2014**. We highly encourage interested individuals from your Institution to take part in this regional initiative.Please feel free to share this program to all your departments and units. We are looking forward to applications from your organization.
