AUN-SCUD Kickoff Meeting

1. BACKGROUND

Universitas Indonesia, represented by Center for Sustainable Infrastructure Development (CSID), as one of the member of Asean University Network (AUN) is assigned as the secretariat for AUN-Sustainable City and Urban Development (AUN-SCUD) thematic network.
